

# Fort Benning Soldier for Life Transition Assistance Program (SFL-TAP) Hosted the first United States Secret Service Pilot - Army Entry Level Assessment Center (ELAC) 21 – 23 October 2016



More than 800 candidates from across the United States applied for Secret Service positions, largely as a result of job announcement marketing efforts of the Fort Benning SFL-TAP Team.



Secret Service agents made maximum use of the facility and were able to conduct up to 17 interviews simultaneously. Interviews began as soon as testing was complete and went as late as 2100.

Approximately 180 Pre-screened candidates attended to take the "POST" test (3 Hour written test). Test results were favorable as approximately 60% of the candidates passed and moved on to the interview process.
