- Paper mills use 40% less energy to make paper from recycled paper than from virgin timber.
- A ton of paper made from recycled fibers conserves 7,000 gallons of water.



Georgia Has Strong Markets for Recyclables

Georgia's paper industry recycles almost 8% of all the paper consumed in the United States. There are 15 paper mills in Georgia using recycled content with 8 of those relying exclusively on recycled fiber.

Paper Recycling Facts

- Approximately 1 billion trees worth of paper are thrown away every year in the United States.
- Americans use 85 million tons of paper a year; about 680 pounds per person.
- The average household throws away 13,000 separate pieces of paper each year. Most is packaging and junk mail.
- The construction costs of a paper mill designed to use waste paper is 50 to 80% less than the cost of a mill using new pulp.
