SUBJECT: Army Permissive Parachuting (PP) and Training Program- Exception to Policy for Best Ranger Competition

1. Reference is made to the attached DA Form 4187, 24 January 2014, and supporting correspondence pertaining to **[RANK FIRST NAME, LAST NAME XXX-XX-XXXX]**, enclosure 1. Pursuant to authority contained in Appendix G, paragraph G-8e, AR 350-1 an exception to the minimum airborne experience criterion is granted for CPT SMITH.
2. It is determined there would be no degradation of the PP program since the recommendation has the signature approval of a General Officer, at the GCMCA level, in the Soldiers chain of command as required by paragraph G-8a, AR 350-1.
3. The following is applicable based on the approval of the permissive parachuting request in favor of **[RANK LAST NAME]**:
 - a. Approval must be only for static-line jumping.
 - b. Hazardous duty pay is not authorized and no orders are published for permissive parachute jumping. Approval will not be longer than six months. Renewals for qualified personnel may be submitted in accordance with paragraph G-8a.
 - c. Soldiers must complete airborne refresher training in accordance with FM 3-21/220 before participating in the planned parachute activity during the period 11-17 April 2016.
 - d. Ensure the Soldiers meet airborne physical qualifications in accordance with AR 40-501, Chapter 5 prior to parachute jumping.
4. Request a copy of your final action is furnished this office, ATTN: DAPE-MPE-DR.
