

What We Do

The Soldier Survey, formerly known as the Post-Combat Survey, is designed to assess current field support, recommend improvements, and inform future modernization efforts across Doctrine, Organization, Training, Materiel, Leadership and Education, Personnel, and Facilities (DOTMLPF). This brochure provides information on the survey and the typical types of questions you can expect.

Since 2003 we have conducted 90 surveys with over 18,000 Soldiers. Surveys are conducted during unit “Lessons Learned Weeks” and with select Army professional development courses. This survey provides Soldiers the opportunity to let us know what is and is not working, therefore it is important that you provide honest feedback. All information collected is completely anonymous. Please do not include names, unit designations, or classified information.

Survey Procedure

The survey will take approximately 30 minutes (depending on your experience) and are completed on laptops in a classroom setting. Typical questions include: scales, single and multi-select, multiple choice, and open-ended. If you have any questions, feel free to discuss with peers or the survey team.



Survey Outcomes

Senior leadership is very interested in your opinions and consistently asks for Soldier feedback prior to making procurement decisions. The Soldier Survey is your opportunity to provide valuable insight. Past survey results have impacted several systems improvements. Examples are listed below.
