SUBJECT: AMMUNITION INFORMATION NOTICE (AIN) 014-16, UNIT GUIDANCE FOR TURN-IN OF CLASS II AND CLASS V (JN17) TASER CARTRIDGES

1. AIN 013-16 WAS TRANSMITTED ON 131909Z Nov 15
2. THIS AIN SUPERSEDES AIN 012-16. REISSUE WAS DONE TO CORRECT POC INFORMATION.

5. REQUEST THIS AIN BE DISSEMINATED TO ALL PERSONNEL THAT EITHER INSPECT, STORE, HANDLE, ISSUE, OR USE SUBJECT AMMUNITION.
6. THE PURPOSE OF THIS AIN IS TO PROVIDE GUIDANCE ON PROPERLY IDENTIFYING THE DIFFERENCES BETWEEN CLASS II UNIT PROCURED CARTRIDGES/NON-LETHAL CAPABILITIES SET (NLCS) AND THE CLASS V JN17 TASER CARTRIDGE.
7. ATTACHMENT AIN 014-16A SHOWS THE ONLY TASER CARTRIDGE (JN17) CURRENTLY AUTHORIZED FOR ISSUE/TURN-IN.
8. CLASS V FIELDDED (JN17), ASP RETURNS:
  - A. EXPENDED JN17 CARTRIDGES REQUIRE NO RESIDUE TURN-IN TO THE ASP. THE USING UNIT WILL SUBMIT A SIGNED CONSUMPTION REPORT TO THE ASP UPON USE. DISPOSE OF ALL RESIDUE IAW LOCAL POLICY FOR NON-HAZARDOUS WASTE OR PROVOST MARSHAL GENERAL (PMG) POLICY/GUIDANCE.
  - B. NON-EXPENDED CARTRIDGES MUST BE TRANSPORTED, HANDLED AND RETURNED WITH THEIR PLASTIC RETENTION SAFETY CLIP IN PLACE (SEE ATTACHMENT AIN 014-16B).

C. MISFIRED CARTRIDGES (ATTEMPTED TO FIRE, CARTRIDGE FAILED TO EXPEL PROBES) MUST BE SEGREGATED FROM SERVICEABLE CARTRIDGES AND RETURNED WITH SAFETY CLIPS IN PLACE.

9. CLASS II ASP RETURNS:

A. CLASS II CARTRIDGES WERE EITHER FIELDIED AS PART OF THE NLCS AS CLASS II ITEMS, OR PURCHASED DIRECTLY FROM THE MANUFACTURER BY ARMY COMMANDS OR DIRECT REPORTING UNITS (DRU) WITH UNIT FUNDS.

B. UNITS SHOULD USE ALL OF THEIR CLASS II CARTRIDGES PRIOR TO REQUISITIONING JN17 TASER CARTRIDGES.

C. SINCE CLASS II CARTRIDGES ARE NOT STORED, ISSUED OR CONTROLLED BY AN ASP, EXPENDED CLASS II NLCS TASER CARTRIDGES AND UNIT PROCURED TASER CARTRIDGES REQUIRE NEITHER THE TURN-IN OF RESIDUE TO THE ASP NOR THE TURN-IN OF A CONSUMPTION REPORT.

D. UNITS SHOULD DISPOSE OF ALL CLASS II RESIDUE IAW LOCAL POLICY FOR NON-HAZARDOUS WASTE OR PROVOST MARSHAL GENERAL (PMG) POLICY/GUIDANCE.

10. FOUND ON INSTALLATION (FOI):

A. TASER CARTRIDGES FOUND ON INSTALLATION WILL BE RECEIVED BY THE ASP AS AN AMNESTY RECEIPT.

B. ASP PERSONNEL SHOULD CLASSIFY AMNESTY TASER CARTRIDGES WITHOUT LOT NUMBERS AS UNSERVICEABLE AND REPORT THEM TO JMC VIA AMMUNITION CONDITION REPORT (ACR) FOR DISPOSITION INSTRUCTIONS.

11. DUE TO THE RISK OF CONTAMINATION WITH BODILY FLUIDS, EXPENDED CARTRIDGES AND PROBES USED ON INDIVIDUALS SHOULD BE DISPOSED OF IAW EITHER LOCAL POLICY FOR HAZARDOUS MEDICAL MATERIAL OR PROVOST MARSHAL POLICY. THE ASP IS NOT THE TURN-IN POINT FOR THESE ITEMS.

12. UNIT GUIDANCE ON BASIC LOAD AND TRAINING ASSETS:

A. 31 DECEMBER 2015 IS THE DEADLINE FOR UNITS TO HAVE EXPENDED ALL OF THEIR CLASS II UNIT PROCURED CARTRIDGES/NON-LETHAL CAPABILITIES SET (NLCS) ITEMS. THE PREFERRED METHOD TO MEET THIS REQUIREMENT IS FOR UNITS TO USE UP THEIR TRAINING STOCKS FIRST, AND THEN ROTATE THEIR BASIC LOAD STOCKS FOR TRAINING USE.

B. ONCE BASIC LOAD STOCKS HAVE BEEN ROTATED FOR TRAINING USE, UNITS SHOULD REPLACE THOSE STOCKS WITH CLASS V ISSUED JN17 CARTRIDGES.
