Quality Assurance Specialist Ammunition Surveillance (QASAS) technical assistance

Headquarters, Army Sustainment Command (ASC) and National Guard Bureau (NGB) are responsible for providing installation-level Logistics Readiness Center (LRC) support including QASAS technical assistance to units within the limits of available resources. Units requiring QASAS technical assistance should develop and coordinate a support agreement or an intra-service support agreement with the supporting Army Field Support Brigade (AFSB)/NGB site for the required technical assistance. The support agreement should outline the technical assistance needed and how funding for such assistance will be provided. AR 5-9, para. 5. provides specific instructions to requesting units for providing funding for common levels of support; i.e. travel, per diem, overtime, etc. .

The installations listed under Responsible Organization will be the Prime ASP providing support to the locations listed under State / Territory / Supported Installation, however, the AFSB/NGB can assign work/support to alternate ASPs/personnel based on workload or other circumstances.
