SUBJECT: Range Safety Waiver for Simpson Range

1. REFERENCES:

2. DISCUSSION: Simpson Range is a Modified Record Fire Range. Based on weapons and ammunition used the Surface Danger Zone (SDZ) extends across a portion of Shelton Range, and a portion of McAndrews Range.

3. Areas to waive: The portion of the SDZ which extends across Shelton Range 145 meters to 225 meters forward of the firing line and a portion of McAndrews Range are waived.

4. Controlling Factors: There is a 12 foot berm that separates Simpson Range and Shelton Range; there is also another 12 foot berm that separates Shelton Range and McAndrews. Based upon the type of firing conducted on Simpson Range, height of the two berms, the statistical probability of any rounds fire from Simpson Range impacting on Shelton and McAndrews Range is Moderate.

5. This waiver is valid for the period of one year when used in conjunction with live fire range scenario and risk management worksheet. In the event of an accident arising from the use of the waived condition, this waiver is invalid until reinstated by this headquarters.



The DD Form 2977 has replaced the DA Form 7566. The mandatory use of the 2977 is predicated upon the attrition of each form renewal, change in the risk approval authority, or document update.
