LTC Allen D. Leth received his Commission as an Infantry Officer from the United States Military Academy in 1997. LTC Leth is the battalion commander for 1st Battalion 29th Infantry Regiment at the Maneuver Center of Excellence (MCoE) at Fort Benning, GA. His previous assignments include: Bradley and Scout Platoon Leader (4th ID, Fort Hood, TX); Division Training Management Officer, Assistant Operations Officer, and Company Commander (25th ID, Schofield Barracks, HI); Instructor in the Department of Physical Education at the USMA (West Point, NY); Squadron Operations Officer and Executive Officer, Regimental Executive Officer, and Deputy Commanding Officer (2d Cavalry Regiment, Vilseck, GE); Executive Officer to the DCG, USAREUR (Heidelberg, GE); and Battalion Commander, 1-8IN 3/4ID (Fort Carson, CO). His most recent assignment was with the MCoE Commanding General's Action Group. LTC Leth has numerous deployments to Eastern Europe and the CENTCOM AOR in various staff and command positions.
