



## **Command Sergeant Major Miles S. Wilson CSM, US Army Armor School**

Command Sergeant Major Miles S. Wilson is a native of Indianapolis, Indiana. He entered the United States Army in January 1986 and completed One Station Unit Training as an Armored Reconnaissance Specialist at Fort Knox, Kentucky.

CSM Wilson's assignments include tours with 2nd Squadron, 2nd ACR in Bamberg, Germany; 1st Battalion, 5th Cavalry at Fort Hood, Texas where he participated in Operation Desert Shield/Storm; Detailed Recruiter in Champaign, IL; 3rd Squadron, 2nd ACR at Fort Polk, Louisiana, where he served in Bosnia in support of SFOR; the United States Army NCO Academy at Fort Knox, Kentucky; 3rd Battalion, 69th Armor at Fort Stewart, Georgia where he deployed in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom I and III; and as the CSM of 4th Squadron, 10th Cavalry regiment where he deployed to Iraq for 15 months as part of the Surge.

Command Sergeant Major Wilson has served in numerous leadership positions within Cavalry and Armor units including Bradley Commander, Section Sergeant, Platoon Sergeant, Squadron Master Gunner, First Sergeant, and Command Sergeant Major. His most recent assignment was the CSM of the 3rd BCT, 4th Infantry Division, where he deployed the brigade as part of Operation Iraqi Freedom and Operation New Dawn.

CSM Wilson's military education includes all levels of the NCO Education System, First Sergeants Course, Bradley Master Gunner Course, Air Assault Course, Army Recruiter Course, and the CSM Force Management Course. He is a graduate of Class 57 of the United States Army Sergeants Major Academy and holds an Associates of Liberal Arts and Science from Central Texas College.
