



The new new neighborhoods have no speed tables, and although I understand they can cause delays in response time for emergency vehicles, Patton and McGraw do not have any major streets which run through them. Adding speed tables would protect our children, just like they in all officer housing areas. If there is not enough man power to staff MPs to deter it, and the signs don't work, its time to take action because it is too dangerous
