**FORT BENNING, Ga.** —About 800 Rangers from the 75<sup>th</sup> Ranger Regiment will conduct a Mass Tactical Airborne Operation, June 22 at 2 p.m. on Fryar Drop Zone. This demonstration will include a military freefall insertion from a Ranger Reconnaissance Team followed by the airborne mass tactical airborne operation.

This event kicks-off Ranger Rendezvous which is a unit tradition and brings the entire Regiment together for the Regimental change of command.
