

To exchange an AIE pass for an AIE CARD:

If you were issued an AIE pass and need to exchange it for an AIE card, you can do this from 2 p.m. - 4 a.m. daily or anytime on Saturday and Sunday, at the Visitor Control Center at the I-185 gate.

Gate closures:

Starting April 15, Benning Boulevard and Sand Hill Access Control Points will close daily from 8 p.m. - 4 a.m. Gates at I-185, Harmony Church, Fort Mitchell/Eddy Bridge will remain open 24/7. Harmony Church gate will have only one lane open during evening hours and weekends. Commercial trucks will continue to enter post at Harmony Church. If you plan to come through the Harmony Church gate on evenings and weekends, expect delays and plan accordingly.

Avoid delays, use other gates:

Due to high volume visitor traffic at the Visitor Control Center at the I-185 gate, drivers with a military ID, CAC or AIE card are advised to use other gates to avoid delays.

ID cards enforced:

Fort Benning will be enforcing gate access policies more stringently, so be sure you have proper identification. Those who show a common access card (CAC card), Military ID, Military Dependent ID, or an Automated Installation Entry Card won't be affected. If you fail to have this ID available, you will be directed to the Visitor Control Center at the I-185 Checkpoint for a Visitor's Pass. All visitors coming to Fort Benning, who do not have a federal government-issued identification card, will be subject to a background check before being allowed to enter the installation.

BRC Visitors:

Visitors attending the Best Ranger Competition will be permitted to enter Fort Benning using a Special Event Lane at the Harmony Church Access Control Gate. On Monday, BRC Visitors attending the Awards Ceremony at Marshall Auditorium may use the far right lane at I-185 Access Control Point. Visitors will need to show a state issued, pictured ID and inform the guard they are attending BRC.
