

Major Changes to MCoE Regulation 200-3 for 2013-2014 Seasons

Ch. 6-1, g. - Guest supervision policy amended to clarify requirements for sponsors to directly supervise guest hunters.

Ch. 6-1, x. - All harvested game must be transported so that it is not in plain view of the public.

Ch. 6-5, g. - Language added to clarify that youth hunters may harvest feral swine with any approved firearms during youth deer seasons.

Ch. 8-1, c. - Three strikes rule added which will result in permanent revocation of hunting privileges if an individual is cited and suspended for three serious violation of MCoE 200-3. Serious violations are defined as any violation that results in a suspension of one or more years as prescribed in Table 8-1.

Table 8-1. - Penalties for violations modified to apply standard penalty for similar violations. Severity of punishment increased for many violations.

Ch. 8-2, c.(8) - Clarification added to address the fact that the community service program, which allows suspended hunters to work off violations to shorten penalties, does not apply to guest hunters.

Ch. 9-3. - Camping policy amended to allow primitive camping at Twilight Pond.

Ch 10-1. - Language added to clarify mandatory deer check requirements.

Table 10-1 - All season dates and bag limits updated to reflect state policies.

Ch. 11-2, g. - Language added referencing new Alabama state harvest reporting requirement.
