MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT: Tactical Combatives Course (Level II) Graduation Requirements

PURPOSE: The purpose of this memorandum is to outline the specific requirements Soldiers need to meet in order to successfully complete the Tactical Combatives Course (Level II) while allowing Instructors to tailor the course to the Unit.

SCOPE: This SOP is to be used by all Tactical Combatives Instructors.

1. For Tactical Combatives Course (Level II), Soldiers must complete all the following:
 - Soldiers must not miss more than a total of 2 course hours.
 - Must compete in the Standard Rules tournament at end of day 5 and complete the Referee Exam.
 - Must participate in all four PEs at the end of day 7-10.
 - Must complete the Techniques Exam with a working knowledge of Tactical Combatives Techniques on the last day of the course.
2. It is recommended that the Two week timeline be used however as respective units have differing needs the timeline is subject to change based on unit discretion as long as it falls within these guidelines. The days of the Standard Rules Tournament and the P.E.s must still be performed on their prospective days and are not subject to change.
3. Those using the modules to complete the course over the 20 week period are to still encouraged follow the timeline as a guideline for their course and must keep the Standard Rules tournament around the end of week 10 and the P.E.s on separate weeks.

Note: The Instructors will utilize a modified Option 3 Drill (all strikes will be to the body, shoulders and arms: no strikes to the head) for Soldiers with TBI documented in their medical records.
