SUBJECT: Authorization to Wear Coyote Brown Boots with Army Combat Uniform in Universal Camouflage Pattern during Ranger Training

1. Due to a depleting local stock of sand boots, Ranger School students are authorized to wear coyote brown boots with the Army Combat Uniform in Universal Camouflage Pattern during Ranger training.
2. Ranger students must wear a proper uniform IAW AR 670-1 for Ranger School graduation. Therefore, Coyote brown boots are not authorized to be worn with the Army Combat Uniform in Universal Camouflage Pattern during Ranger School graduation.
3. This memorandum will remain in effect during the Army Combat Uniform transition phase through 30 SEP 2019.
