



ACCESS CONTROL POINT UPDATE FROM FORT BENNING POLICE DEPARTMENT



Eisenhower Interchange traffic flow is being modified to benefit Sand Hill, Patton and McGraw. This change will require the use of many jersey barriers, it may look ugly but it will free up movement and provide 24/7 access to the area.

Effective Date:

1 MARCH (Operational)

- We will work with SHAW/DPW to erect all barriers during weekend prior (low traffic time)

Public Awareness:

- Bayonet coverage for last two issues of FEBRUARY
- Resident email through The Villages of Benning management offices

Second attachment (entitled *Current ACPs*) lays out current ACP operations before Eisenhower Intersection Change

Change will impact ACPs in the following manner:

- ACPs 4 will become free flow and unmanned 24/7
- ACP 5A will be 24/7 manning for traffic off post, onpost / intra-post will be free flowing
- ACP 5B remains unchanged
