



BRIGADIER GENERAL PETER L. JONES COMMANDANT, UNITED STATES ARMY INFANTRY SCHOOL

Brigadier General Jones was commissioned as an Infantry Officer in the U.S. Army upon graduation from the United States Military Academy in 1985. Throughout his career, BG Jones has served in numerous staff and leadership positions, both in the continental United States and overseas, and commanded from Company through Brigade.

BG Jones' command assignments include Commander, 3rd Brigade, 3rd Infantry Division at Fort Benning, GA while serving in Operation IRAQI FREEDOM (OIF) & Operation NEW DAWN; Commander, 1st Battalion, 6th Infantry, 1st Armored Division during OIF 1; Commander, C Company, 1 - 6th Infantry, 1st Armored Division, United States Army Europe and Seventh Army, Vilseck, Germany.

BG Jones' principal staff assignments include Deputy Commanding General – Support, 3rd Infantry Division, Ft. Stewart, GA; Executive Officer to the Secretary of the Army, at the Pentagon; Chief, Joint Interagency Task Force-Iraq, Headquarters Multi-National Force-Iraq; Assistant Chief of Staff, G-3, 1st Armored Division, Wiesbaden, Germany; Executive Officer, 2nd Brigade, 1st Infantry Division, Schweinfurt, Germany; Deputy Chief of Staff, Multinational Brigade (East) TASK FORCE FALCON, Camp Bondsteel, Kosovo; Operations Officer (S-3), 2nd Brigade, 1st Infantry Division; Executive Officer, 1 - 18th Infantry; and Chief of Plans, 1st Infantry Division, United States Army Europe and Seventh Army, Wurzburg, Germany.

Prior to his arrival at the Maneuver Center of Excellence, he most recently served as the Director of Future Plans (CJ35), International Security Assistance Force Joint Command, later Resolute Support Mission Joint Command, North Atlantic Treaty Organization, OPERATION FREEDOM'S SENTINEL, Afghanistan. Brigadier General Jones assumed duties as the Infantry School Commandant and Chief of Infantry on 28 September 2015.
