From August 2012 to April 2014 he served as the Regimental S3X where he oversaw Special Access Programs for the 75th Ranger Regiment. CSM Young's last assignment was as the Operations Sergeant Major for the Special Troops Battalion, 75th Ranger Regiment from April 2014 to October 2016.
