

Come Prepared

All information on this page is also in the RSLC Student Handout. However, we are highlighting some of the common discrepancies that we discover during inprocessing and throughout the course.

MEDICAL

- Your Medical **MUST** be complete (every page and **NOT EXPIRED**) and signed by a Medical Doctor, not a PA.
- You must have a PANOREX or Memo from your Dental facility stating that you have one on file, don't plan having time to have it faxed here.
- You **CANNOT** be on PROFILE and attend this course.
- You **MUST** have a [PRK/LASIK waiver](#) if you have had the surgery, not waivable if less than 3 months.
- If you are on Medication, you will not be allowed to take certain medications during the course, call ahead to verify.

PREPARATION

We highly recommend that units implement familiarization training for prospective students on high frequency radio communications, vehicle & equipment identification ([download slide show from this site](#)), and land navigation ([Self Study](#)). These are the areas that students have the most problems with. Also, emphasize the importance of physical fitness as students are required to participate in numerous PT events such as: standard runs (up to 8 miles), and foot marches (7 miles, 55lb ruck, 15 min/mile). Simply passing the APFT will not set students up for success during the course.

Additionally, we encourage units to use recent RSLC graduates to facilitate preparing prospective students for the course. Do not come UNPREPARED.

OTHER

- (Effective September 2006) Bring a copy of your waivers if applicable [Qualification Waiver](#) or [Rank Waiver](#).
- Bring a copy of your DA873 - Certificate of Clearance (SECRET) at a minimum an interim SECRET clearance.
- Bring a copy of your current Hazardous Duty Orders (ensure that they are not expired)
- Bring 2 copies of your individual orders or 1610
