





INFANTRY OFFICER CANDIDATE COURSE

1. Pursuant to instructions contained in letter, OCAFF, ATTN:G-12 (OCS)(C), 7 December 1950, subject, "Officer Candidate School," and teletype 5711, OCAFF, 18 December 1950, the Infantry Officer Candidate Course is established at The Infantry School.

2. Mission.

The mission of the Infantry Officer Candidate Course is to develop and produce competent Infantry combat platoon leaders.

3. The Commandant.

The Commandant of The Infantry School is charged with the direction of the Officer Candidate Course.

4. The Assistant Commandant.

The Assistant Commandant is directly responsible to the Commandant for the conduct, supervision, and administration of instruction presented to officer candidates, and for the evaluation, certification of successful candidates for graduation and commission and elimination of unsuccessful candidates.

5. Director Of Officer Candidates.

The Director of Officer Candidates is the principal Staff Officer of the Assistant Commandant for all matters pertaining to officer candidates, to include the following duties:

- a. Exercise broad supervision of all Tactical Officers.
- b. Establish and operate the Candidate Faculty Board.
- c. Implement the Officer Candidate evaluation program.
- d. Maintain statistics and records of classes and students in a manner to keep the Assistant Commandant continually informed of the status and progress of officer candidates.
- e. Administer a system of interview for all officer candidates.
- f. Maintain liaison with Student Training Regiment.

6. Commanding Officer, Student Training Regiment.

The Commanding Officer of the Student Training Regiment is responsible for the following:

- a. Housing, administration, and discipline of all officer candidates and cadre assigned.
- b. Maintenance of administrative and evaluation records, except academic grades, of all candidates.
- c. Conduct, supervision, and administration of instruction not delegated to the Academic Department.
- d. Selection, training, and supervision of all Tactical Officers.

7. Tactical Officers.

Tactical Officers are charged with the following:

- a. Normal command responsibilities of their respective organizations.
- b. Accompanying candidates on all practical work.
- c. Individually knowing each candidate in their platoons. The Company Commander must know individual candidates in sufficient numbers to enable him to check the judgment of his platoon leaders.
- d. Assisting the candidate to attain the required standard for officer candidates.
- e. Assigning candidates in rotation to command positions in the field and in barracks.
- f. Assessing and recording delinquencies.
- g. Observing and recording of candidate's manner of performance and soldierly qualities.
- h. Evaluating and rating candidates in order of merit.
- i. Administering candidate evaluation forms and records.
- j. Recommending candidates who fail to fulfill the prescribed adaptability standards for appearance before the Candidate Faculty Board.
- k. Instructing candidates in such subjects as may be prescribed by the Commandant. This instruction will be supervised by the Academic Department, The Infantry School, to insure uniformity.
