

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

4. Limitations: This Unit will be maintained at authorized strength. Personnel will remain stabilized during the training phases. No more than twenty-five (25) percent turn-over is authorized between training phases.

5. Responsibilities:

a. The Commanding Officer, The School Brigade, will command, administer and provide logistical support for all trainees assigned or attached to 43rd Company. He commands, administers, conducts mandatory training, and provides logistical support to all cadre of 43rd Company. He exercises disciplinary control over all officers and enlisted men assigned or attached to 43rd Company. The School Brigade Commander will make available to the Military Chief, United States Army Infantry Human Research Unit, personnel assigned to the 43rd Company to conduct basic training of recruits and research projects as initiated by the Military Chief, United States Army Infantry Human Research Unit, United States Continental Army Command.

b. The Military Chief, United States Army Infantry Human Research Unit, will schedule, direct, prepare, and be responsible for all formal training of trainees attached to 43rd Company. He will be responsible for procuring all training supplies and equipment (other than individual clothing and equipment). He will also be responsible for the conduct and supply of all research projects initiated.

6. Funds: Nonappropriated unit funds will be established in accordance with AR 230-5, administered in accordance with AR 230-10, and accounted for in accordance with AR 230-21.

7. Records: The AR 345-292 series will govern maintenance and disposition of records accumulated. An inventory of the records will be made and AR 345-292 with appropriate extracts for review will be submitted within ninety (90) days of the effective date of this order.



e. Issue field equipment as required to officers assigned to the Academic Department of The Infantry School (TD 63-3440-1).


f. Provide administrative and logistical support to other personnel as directed by The Commandant, The Infantry School.
