COMMUNITY NOTICE: wildfires update

FORT BENNING, Ga. – Two wildfires continue to burn in the A-20 and K-15 impact areas.

The K-15 Impact Area wildfire is still burning with smoke moving west towards the midtown area of Columbus.

The A-20 Impact Area wildfire behind Peirce Range began today and is burning in A-20 with smoke moving into Main Post.

Both fires are contained and secured by firebreak area.

This wildfire is expected to burn into the evening and night. Most of Main Post could be affected by smoke this evening, tonight and tomorrow.
