

Biographical Sketch COL Jason H. Rosenstrauch

COL Jason H. Rosenstrauch is a graduate of Purdue University where he earned a Bachelor of Science Degree in Civil Engineering and a commission into the United States Army as an Armor Officer. Following the Officers Basic Course, he served in 1st (Tiger) Squadron, 3rd Armored Cavalry Regiment at Fort Carson, Colorado assigned as a tank platoon leader, scout platoon leader, and troop executive officer from 1999 to 2003.

Upon completion of the Armor Officer Advanced Course and Combined Arms Staff Services School, COL Rosenstrauch served as the assistant operations officer in 2nd ACR at Fort Polk, and then moved to Fort Lewis, Washington as part of 4/2 Stryker Brigade Combat team. He served as the commander of B Troop, 2-1 Cavalry Squadron from 2006-2008.

Following Company Command, COL Rosenstrauch served first as a cavalry troop observer controller at the Joint Readiness Training Center (JRTC) at Fort Polk, Louisiana and then as a rotational plans officer from 2008 to 2010. He then transferred to 4/10 Mountain Division serving as the 3-89 Cavalry Squadron Operations Officer, Brigade Operations Officer and Brigade Executive Officer from 2010 to 2013. He subsequently attended the School of Advanced Military Studies (SAMS) at Fort Leavenworth, Kansas in 2014.

COL Rosenstrauch then served as the Division G5 for 4th Infantry Division at Fort Carson, Colorado. He was then privileged to serve as the commander of 2-1 Cavalry Squadron in 1st SBCT, 4th Infantry Division from 2015-2017. After command, he served in Korea as an operational planner in the CJ35 for U.S. Forces Korea and the Combined Forces Command. Following attendance at the U.S. Army War College, COL Rosenstrauch most recently served as the Army Capability Manager ABCT and Reconnaissance at Fort Benning, GA.
