SUBJECT: United States Army Combatives School equipment requirements for Basic Combatives Instructor Course (Level III) MTT

1. The following list will ensure successful completion of a Basic Combatives Instructor Course (Level III) MTT conducted at a user unit location.
 - 36 pr X Serviceable 16 oz boxing gloves
 - 18 pr X Serviceable boxing focus mitts
 - 02 ea X Serviceable male groin protection
 - 02 ea X Serviceable female groin protection
 - 36 ea X Serviceable standard head gear
 - 02 ea X Serviceable full face head gear
 - 01 ea X Serviceable 24' boxing ring or Cage
 - 8 square feet of matted floor area per student
 - 03 ea X Serviceable suspended heavy bags
 - 36 pr X Serviceable shin and instep pads
 - 18 pr X Serviceable Muay Thai pads
 - 18 ea X Serviceable kicking shield (suitcase bag)
 - 02 ea X Serviceable blue martial arts belts
 - 02 ea X Serviceable red martial arts belts
 - 08 pr X Serviceable knee pads
 - 04 ea X 100,000 volt Hand held tazer
 - 02 ea X Airsoft M-9 pistol with holster
 - 03 ea X Serviceable stopwatches
 - 12 ea X Serviceable impact reduction suits
 - 18 ea X Serviceable M-9 holster
 - 18 ea X Serviceable M-9 Redgun handgun training replica
 - 02 ea X Serviceable paintball facemask
 - 18 ea X Serviceable M-4 rifle training replica
 - 18 ea X Serviceable tactical slings
 - 16 ea X Training Knives
 - 16 pr X Flex Cuffs
 - 01 ea X Proxima
 - 01 ea X Proxima Screen

2. Every student must provide one serviceable mouth guard, three (3) complete sets of serviceable uniforms (ACU's), Two (2) complete set of PT's, one pair of hand wraps, and groin protection. Additionally all students are required to bring MICH, ACH, or Similar Helmet, Body Armor, Elbow and Knee Protection, Gloves, Eye Protection, and Camelback.
3. The unit should provide two additional Basic Combatives Instructor Course (Level III) qualified instructors to act as assistant instructors. In the event that the Basic Combatives Instructor Course (Level III) assistant instructors are not available, the United States Army Combatives School must provide all three cadres thereby decreasing the availability of MTTs.
