

Colonel Peter C. Glass



Colonel Peter C. Glass was commissioned as an Infantry (IN) Officer following his graduation from The Citadel. His first assignment was with the 3rd IN Division (DIV) at Fort Stewart, GA. While at Fort Stewart, he served as a Rifle Platoon Leader, Battalion (BN) Adjutant, and Company (CO) Executive Officer (XO) in 3rd BN, 7th IN.

In 2001, COL Glass graduated from the Infantry Captains Career Course and was subsequently assigned to the XVIII Airborne Corps as an operations (OPS) officer in the HHC. After a deployment to Afghanistan, COL Glass branch transferred to Armor and was assigned to 3rd Brigade (BDE) Combat Team, 1st Cavalry (CAV) DIV 3rd BN, 8th CAV Regiment (REG) at Fort Hood, TX as an Assistant S-3. After his staff time, he was the Commander of Charlie CO, 3rd BN, 8th CAV REG, which was attached to 2nd BN, 7th CAV REG during OIF II. While deployed the company participated in combat operations in An Najaf and Operation Al-Fajr, the second battle of Fallujah.

After completion of company Command, COL Glass was assigned to the National Training Center (NTC) where he was an Observer Controller. While at NTC he earned a Master Degree from Webster University in Management and Leadership.

In 2009, COL Glass graduated from the College of Naval Command and Staff at the Naval War College in Newport, Rhode Island. During this period, he received a Masters of Arts in National Security and Strategic Studies. He was then assigned to 3rd BDE, 4th IN DIV at Fort Carson, CO where he served in 1st BN, 68th Armor as the XO and OPS Officer. In this capacity, he deployed with the BN to Iraq in support of OIF/OND. Additionally, he served as the BDE OPS Officer and XO for 3rd BDE, 4th IN DIV. As the BDE XO, he deployed to Afghanistan as a Security Force Advisor Transition Team in the Operations Coordination Center-South in Kandahar.

Following his time at Fort Carson, he was as an instructor, later Assistant Professor, at the Command and General Staff Officer College in the Department of Army Tactics at Fort Leavenworth, KS. COL Glass was the BN Commander for 2nd BN, 7th IN REG at Fort Stewart, GA. He deployed the BN in support of Operation Atlantic Resolve – once to Spain and once to Germany.

In 2017-2018, COL Glass attended Senior Service College at the National War College, upon completion he was awarded a Master's of Science in National Security Strategy. While attending National War College, he earned an additional distinction from the College of Information and Cyberspace by completing the Cyber Security Leadership Concentration Program. His most recent assignment was at the Pentagon on the Joint Staff in the J5, Strategy, Plans and Policy in the Deputy Directorate – Asia, where he was the Deputy DIV Chief for China, Taiwan, and Mongolia.

COL Glass' awards and decorations include: Bronze Star Medal (2-V Devices, 3 OLC), Purple Heart, Defense Meritorious Service Medal, Meritorious Service Medal (3 OLC), Army Commendation Medal (3 OLC), Joint Service Achievement Medal, Army Achievement Medal (4 OLC), Presidential Unit Citation, Joint Meritorious Unit Award (1 OLC), Meritorious Unit Citation (1 OLC), Navy Unit Citation, National Defense Service Medal, Afghanistan Campaign Medal (2 BSTR), Iraq Campaign Medal (1 BSTR), Global War on Terrorism (GWOT) Expeditionary Medal, GWOT Service Medal, Army Service Ribbon, Overseas Service Ribbon (2), NATO Medal, Combat Action Badge, Expert Infantryman's Badge and Parachutist Badge.
