

# 75TH CAVALRY REGIMENT



The star represents the explosion of a shell; the cloud of dust represents the result of the explosion. The distinctive unit insignia was originally approved for 705<sup>th</sup> Tank Destroyer Battalion July 9, 1942. It was redesignated for 330<sup>th</sup> Mechanized Cavalry Reconnaissance Squadron Feb. 9, 1948. It was redesignated for 705<sup>th</sup> Tank Battalion July 25, 1952. The insignia was redesignated for 75<sup>th</sup> Cavalry Regiment, with the description updated Oct. 18, 2004.
