Graduates of the program will receive advanced placement and credit toward completing the Boilermakers National Apprenticeship Program (up to 50% of the program) for all classes completed and welding certifications obtained during their Pre-Apprenticeship CSP.

Completing our Pre-Apprenticeship Career Skills Program will give you direct entry into the Boilermakers National Apprenticeship Program in either the Local Lodge within the geographical jurisdiction of your residence or the National Transient District Lodge.
