

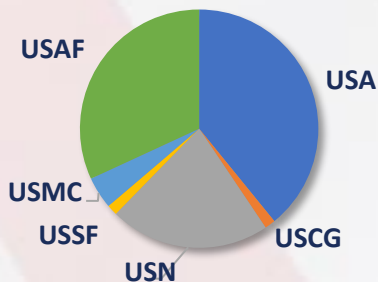

Annual Review: May 15, 2022 - May 15, 2023

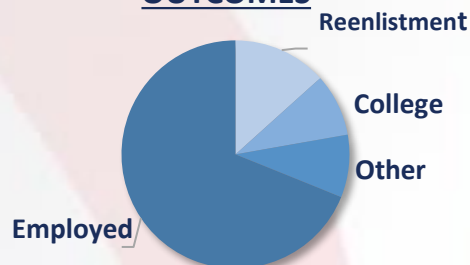
Who Our Interns Are:

- The RecruitMilitary SkillBridge Program had 70 transitioning servicemembers intern as Candidate Success Representatives, Help Desk Analysts, Public Affairs Specialists and Recruiting Specialists.
- All military branches of service participated: USA, USN, USAF, USMC, USCG and USSF.
- Interns ranged from E4-E9 as well as Officers and Warrant Officers.
- Education levels ranged from High School to Masters Degrees and Professional Certifications.
- Representation came from 40 military installations; both CONUS and OCONUS.

What Our Interns Did:

- Supported 50,000+ military candidates with building RM profiles, resumes, job searches and event registrations.
- Received more than 480 hours of on-the-job training (OJT).
- Each participant received more than 60 hours of professional development via seminars, webinars, coaching and mentorship
- More than 200 job interviews conducted between employers and interns.
- Interns were given a voice via published articles, live broadcasts, hiring event support, web content creation.
- Accepted job offers with an average annual salary of \$65,000.
