## Frequently Asked Questions

**Q:** What should I place in my desk-side bin?

**A:** The desk-side bins should be used for white paper and will be picked up at your desk weekly by your Recycling Team. Separated white paper has a higher resale value than mixed paper.

**Q:** Can I use my desk-side bin for other recyclables?

**A:** Yes. However, desk-side pickup will be for white paper only. For the Pilot Program, we do not have capacity to sort materials on-site. If you use your bin for other recyclables, please take them to the floor recycle bins and sort appropriately.

**Q:** What do I put in the oversized recycle bins located at the end of the hallway or centrally located in our offices?

**A:** The centrally located, oversized recycle bins are also for mixed papers such as colored paper, newspapers, magazines, and envelopes. White paper can go here too, but if you keep it separated in the desk-side bin, it has a higher resale value.

**Q:** Can I recycle glass bottles?

**A:** At this time, we cannot recycle glass bottles, so the recycle containers located in the snack bar areas or in the hallway are only for aluminum cans and plastic bottles. We are evaluating options for future glass bottle recycling.

**Q:** What should I do with cardboard boxes?

**A:** Cardboard boxes should be broken down and taken outside to the cardboard dumpsters located next to the refuse dumpsters OR stacked neatly, in such a way as to prevent tripping hazards, next to the central recycle bins.

**Q:** When are the floor recycle bins picked up?

**A:** The floor recycle bins are picked up on a weekly basis by your Fort Benning Recycling Team.
