

The Career Skills Program prepares
Service Members for civilian employment
through first class apprenticeships,
Employment Skills Training (EST),
Internships, and job shadowing within a
your last 180-days of service. During the
participation in a CSP, Service Members
will continue to earn their military pay,
health care, and benefits.

Eligibility:

- Anticipated honorable separation
- Must be within 180-days of ETS/ Retirement Date
- Must have a completed DDForm 2648
- Secure Commander's Approval

The second purpose is to give Soldiers a chance to support each other in times of financial need. (A Core Army Value)



Veterans legislation enacted in 2023

- Veterans' Compensation Cost-of-Living Adjustment of 2023 (Public Law 118-6): Increased all VA disability compensation rates and the rates of Dependency and Indemnity Compensation for survivors of certain disabled veterans.
- Fiscal Year 2023 Veterans Affairs Major Medical Facility Authorization Act (Public Law 118-8): Authorized the VA to carry out specified major medical facility projects during fiscal year 2023. The bill also provided the maximum funding levels that could be spent on each project.
- Wounded Warrior Access Act (Public Law 118–21): Required the VA to establish and maintain a secure online tool or website to enable a claimant or claimant's representative to make records requests related to VA claims and benefits. A request for records must specify in which format the copy is desired. The VA must also notify a requester within 10 days that the request has been received and must fulfill the request within 120 days.












Grange ACP Phase 2

MACH Update

Military Medical Records Request

- Medical Records: Hospital Basement, Room BC-150
- Hours:
 - Monday-Wednesday & Friday: 0800-1600
 - Thursday: 1300-1600
- Request "Complete Medical Records Request"; turnaround time ~ 45 calendar days
- Digital copy of medical records will be provided
- May need to submit a "Partial Medical Records Request" for any healthcare received between "Complete Medical Records Request" and when exit service





MACH Update

Medical Records Request - Tips

- Civilian Medical Records If during your time on active duty, you had any healthcare delivered outside the military healthcare system, you will need to request a copy of those records from each healthcare facility where that care was rendered.
- Upon receipt of your health records
 - Print records, one sided
 - Arrange records in chronological order
- Review your records to ensure the records contain everything. If something is missing, you will need to submit another "Partial Medical Records Request" for the missing timeframe. The timeframe is needed for this request. Also, if you know where you were during that timeframe (i.e., the military installation), that helps.
- The longer you were in service and the more healthcare you sought increases the volume of medical records you have on file. In turn, this increases the time required to process your request and the time needed for you to review your records. Plan accordingly.





MACH Update

Separation Physicals

WHO: Service Members

WHAT: Final physical

<u>WHEN</u>: Up to 12 months prior to separation date; recommended at 6 months; absolute latest is 90 days. Upon separation, will need to declare any health issues identified since separation physical.

WHERE: Work with PCM or respective TMC
