
Camp NIM

- **What:** Camp NIM is a day camp that introduces campers to the Army Core Values, leadership skills, teamwork, and how to apply it to their every day lives using hands-on activities and real-life experiences.
- **When:** 2JUN-11JUL
- **Who:** Children ages 7-14
- **Where:** WWII Company Street at the National Infantry Museum
- **Cost:** \$180 per camper with active duty/veteran parent or guardian. \$190 per camper when registering more than one child in a family. \$200 per camper for non-military families registering only one child. *Scholarships are available upon application.*

Curfew. All dependents/guests under the age of 16 are required to be in quarters:

- 2100 and 0600 **Sunday through Thursday**;
 - 2200 - 0600 on **Friday, Saturday, Holidays** and non-school nights;
 - Unless accompanied by a parent or guardian.
- Dependents and sponsored guests under the age of 16
 - May travel, on or off post, between their quarters and social events, work, youth services events, community events, and school functions,
 - With the consent of the sponsor or guardian after curfew hours without being in violation of this policy.

Quiet Hours. Observed between:

- 2200 and 0800 Sunday through Thursday,
- 0001 and 0800 on Friday and Saturday.
- Outside of established quiet hours, residents are required to control the volume of stereos, televisions and musical devices within their home so that they do not disturb the residents of other homes.

Conduct of family members, guests, and domestics.

- Individuals who live on Fort Benning **are responsible for the conduct of all** members of their family, their guests, and domestic employees while occupying said home.
- **Unbecoming conduct, failure to live in harmony with neighbors** or failure to comply with policies concerning police and maintenance of their assigned home may result in their exclusion from Fort Benning.

Prohibitions against profanity and obscene language.

- The use of obscene, vulgar, or profane language in any public area on the Fort Benning military reservation is prohibited.



Moving Day

- Carefully read the information on the **bill of lading, inventory, and all other completed documents** before you sign them.
- Accompany the movers as they inventory your household goods and resolve any questions regarding the **condition of materials** being moved.
- Take **pictures/videos of high value property**, and the condition they are in. Record serial numbers. Have receipts showing ownership of the property.
- Separate items you are taking with you in another room. **Tell movers what in your house is off limits.**
- During packing and load up day **have children watched by a neighbor or babysitter** so they are not distractions and are kept safe.
- Be present to answer questions and give directions to the movers. Stay until they finish.
- **Before the moving truck leaves**, take one final look throughout the house to make certain nothing has been left behind.
- Keep the **bill of lading until your goods are delivered**, and any claims are settled.
- Know the claims process.

Delivery Day

- Be present to answer any questions and give directions.
- Supervise unloading and unpacking of your goods.
- Note on the inventory list all boxes or items that are damaged or missing before you sign any documents.





MACH Update

Pharmacy: Cold & Seasonal Allergy Care Program (CSAC)

- Outpatient pharmacist-driven program.
- Patient will be assessed based on their symptoms with a medication recommendation from a list of available medications.
- Max day supply: 30 days.
- Maximum number of 4 items per DODID carrier at pharmacist discretion based on symptoms.

This is not an OTC (over-the-counter) program.



MACH Update

- Retirees and Dependent Beneficiaries use the Main Outpatient Pharmacy during normal operating hours.
- Active-Duty Service Members only at the following TMCs:
 - CTMC
 - Sledgehammer
 - TMC4 at Eglin

****Not available at Winder or Harmony Church TMCs due to trainee populations****

After Hours Care

Request from Window 11 (Pharmacy ED window) without having to be seen by an ED provider. However, ED patients will take precedence.



MACH Update

- Tricare Beneficiaries ONLY.
- Have a current PCM (Primary Care Manager) at the MTF.
- Need treatment for cold and/or allergy symptoms.
 - Reviewed by outpatient pharmacist deeming which medicine would be best to resolve patient's symptoms.
- How to request?
 - Pull ticket at the Q-Flow kiosk as if you are activating a brand-new prescription.
 - At the window indicate you want CSAC.
 - Outpatient pharmacist will assess the patient's symptoms, recommend from a list of available medications.



MACH Update

School and Sports Physicals

- No dedicated date/time for school and sports physicals.
- For children with an annual wellness exam within the last 6-12 months, Pediatrics will transcribe that information onto a school, sports, or CYS form. Families can retrieve the completed forms either through the patient portal or in person.
- Otherwise, Pediatrics plans to maximize access during the summer break timeframe to accommodate as many wellness exams as possible, which can also serve as school and sports physicals.
