BRC Team Makeup Guidance

- All participating units must send at least one team consisting of only enlisted Rangers (no officers).
- All additional teams may only have one officer per team and must consist of at least one enlisted Ranger.
 - Example:
 - Team 1: Enlisted, Enlisted
 - Team 2: Enlisted, Officer/Warrant Officer
- Rangers who have won in previous years are excluded from competing again, all others may compete regardless of previous participation.

BRC Team Allocation Guidance

- No more than 60 total teams are invited to the Best Ranger Competition.
- Units not on the 2025 BRC team allocation list who would like to request a team must coordinate with the allocated units and request one of their team slots.
- Units who are not able to fill all their teams can give their available teams to any unit not already on the team allocation list.
 - Example:
 - If X unit can only fill two of three allocated teams, it can provide one team to a unit not listed.
 - If X unit did not receive a team allocation, they must coordinate with any unit listed to use one of their slots.

Exceptions To Guidance

- The Infantry Commandant is the approval authority for any exception to the 2025 BRC team makeup and allocation guidance.
- All requests for exception and any team exchanges must be communicated to and coordinated with the Office of the Chief Of Infantry, Infantry Commandant NLT 28 FEB 2025.
