

Lt. Col. Ben Scott

Lieutenant Colonel Ben Scott commissioned as an Armor Officer through ROTC at The University of Tennessee in 2006. After initial officer training, he served as a Platoon Leader, Company Executive Officer, and Assistant Operations Officer in 1-23 IN, 3d SBCT, 2d ID. During this time, he deployed twice to Iraq (2007, 2009-2010) and successfully branch transferred into the Infantry.

After the Maneuver Captains Career Course, he was assigned to 1-506th IN, 4th IBCT, 101st ABN DIV (AASLT) where he served as an Assistant Operations Officer and Rifle Company Commander. While assigned to 1-506th IN, he twice deployed to Afghanistan (2011, 2013). LTC Scott then commanded Headquarters Support Company (HSC), 101st ABN DIV (AASLT). He deployed with HSC in support of Operation United Assistance, the US military's support to combating Ebola in Liberia and West Africa (2014-2015). LTC Scott later commanded D/2-11 IN (IBOLC).

After attending the Army Command and General Staff College and the School of Advanced Military Studies at Fort Leavenworth, KS, he was assigned to 25 ID and served as a G35 Future Operations Planner, Squadron Executive Officer in 2-14 CAV, and Battalion Operations Officer in 1-27 IN.

Following his assignment to 25 ID, LTC Scott transitioned to US Army Cyber Command where he served sequentially as a Cyber Operations Planner, Security Cooperation Division Chief, and Chief of Plans and Strategy.

Lieutenant Colonel Scott's awards and decorations include the Bronze Star Medal(1OLC), Meritorious Service Medal (3 OLC), Humanitarian Service Medal, Combat and Expert Infantryman Badges, and Ranger Tab. LTC Scott is married to Tracy Scott, and the couple have three children: Ben IV, Ryan, and Frankie.
