

LTC Kevin Robert McCabe

LTC Kevin R. McCabe graduated from Saint John's University in Collegeville, MN and received his commission in 2007 then completed the Infantry Officer's Basic Course at Fort Benning, GA.

LTC McCabe's first duty assignment was with the 3rd Infantry Division at Fort Stewart, GA from 2008-2010, in which he deployed in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom and Operation New Dawn. Kevin served as an assistant operations officer, platoon leader, and company executive officer while stationed with 3rd Infantry Division. Kevin was subsequently assigned to the Ranger Training Brigade, 2010-2013, as a Platoon Trainer and Company Commander.

After completion of the Maneuver Captain's Career Course, LTC McCabe was assigned to the 101st Airborne Division (AASLT), from 2014-2018. He was an assistant division operations officer, brigade S3 (rear-detachment), 1-26 Infantry company commander, and battalion operations officer. He deployed twice with the "Screaming Eagles" in support of Operations Enduring Freedom and Inherent Resolve.

After completing the Command and General Staff College at Fort Leavenworth, KS 2017-2018 LTC McCabe was assigned to the Airborne and Ranger Training Brigade, from 2018-2021, serving as the 4th Battalion Executive Officer, Brigade Operations, and Brigade Executive Officer.

LTC McCabe commanded B Company, 2nd Battalion, 1st Security Forces Assistance Brigade, from 2021-2024, employing his teams across five countries within Central and South America. Kevin's most recent assignment was to the Office Chief of Infantry, at Fort Moore, GA, as the Chief of Strategic Initiatives.

LTC McCabe's awards and decorations include the Bronze Star Medal (1x OLC), the Meritorious Service Medal (2x OLC), the Army Commendation Medal (6x OLC), the Army Achievement Medal (6x OLC), the Meritorious Unit Citation, the Senior Parachutist, The Combat and Expert Infantryman's Badges, He is a graduate of the Ranger Course, Jump Master School, and the Air Assault School.
