LTC Michael Moore was born in Chicago, IL and raised in Indiana. He was commissioned as an Air Force Officer from Miami University (OH) in 2004, and later transferred to the Army as an Infantry Officer through the Blue to Green Program in May 2006.

LTC Moore's company-grade assignments include Rifle Platoon Leader with C Co, 1-504 PIR, 1BCT, 82nd Airborne Division, later Assistant S3, 1-504 PIR at Fort Bragg, NC from 2007-2009. While serving as a Platoon Leader, LTC Moore deployed to Baghdad, Iraq as part of the 2007 Surge. Upon completion of the Maneuver Captains Career Course at Fort Benning, GA, LTC Moore returned to Fort Bragg to serve with 1-325 AIR, 2BCT, 82nd Airborne Division. LTC Moore later assumed command of HHC, 2BCT, 82nd Airborne Division, and then completed is company-grade and junior field-grade time as the G3 Air for the 82nd Airborne Division.

LTC Moore completed ILE at the Command and General Staff College, Fort Leavenworth, KS. Following ILE, he served with the 4th Infantry Division at Fort Carson, CO from 2016-2019.
