- 1. Your battalion commander conducted a sensing session and discovered that several platoon leaders, platoon sergeants, and company commanders did not feel tactically proficient. Because of recent events, your battalion commander believes that your unit may get deployed on short notice to LSCO in the next six months without additional training time.
 - **a.** Write an information paper for leaders in your organization to effectively self-develop their tactical skills using information from ADP 6-22, FM 6-22, or other doctrine. Include specific recommendations and original thought.

OR

- **b.** Write an information paper for leaders in your organization to get the most tactical value from limited training time using AR 350-1, TC 20.11, TC 3-20.0, FM 7-0, FM 6-22, or other doctrine. Include specific recommendations and original thought.
- 2. After a scandal in another unit where the battalion commander was relieved for counterproductive leadership, your battalion commander asked you to write an information paper on how to change the culture of a unit to build a cohesive team using AR 600-20, ADP 6-22, or other doctrine. Include specific recommendations and original thought.

You must use sources for your paper and you must include your original thoughts. Write the paper as if you are writing for publication. This paper should have actual value for the force.
