The OCS Hall of Fame board convenes in December 2019 and letters of congratulations/regret will be immediately sent out. Results will be posted on the OCS home page shortly thereafter.

To complete the application, 3-11 IN OCS requires a typed biographical sketch, OCS Graduation orders, four color photographs of the nominee (two 8x10 and two 5x7 inches in size) and a signed Privacy Act waiver. The acceptable attire for nominee photos is the Army Service Uniform, Class A Uniform, or business suit. Photos will be taken from the waist up without headgear.
