



Lieutenant Colonel Christopher M. Green



Lieutenant Colonel Christopher Green graduated from the United States Military Academy in 2003 and was commissioned as an Infantry Officer.

LTC Green's first duty assignment as a second lieutenant was with the 3rd Brigade, 101st Airborne Division (AASLT) at Fort Campbell, KY. During his time in 3-101st he served as a Rifle Platoon Leader, Dismounted Reconnaissance Platoon Leader and Troop Executive Officer. While assigned to 3-101st, LTC Green was selected for a special assignment to 3rd Battalion, 75th Ranger Regiment where he served as a Ranger Rifle Platoon Leader and Ranger Company Executive Officer in B Company. During his time with 3/75 RGR, he completed two deployments in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom and one deployment in support of Operation Enduring Freedom. Upon completion of his time with 3/75 RGR, he remained at Fort Benning to attend the Maneuver Captains Career Course.

After graduation from the Captains Career Course he was assigned to 2nd Brigade, 4th Infantry Division at Fort Carson, CO. LTC Green first served as an Assistant Operations Officer in 2nd Battalion, 8th Infantry before taking command of A Company in June 2009 in Basra, Iraq. Following 22 months in command of A Company, LTC Green was assigned to the Brigade headquarters as a planner and deployed to Operation Enduring Freedom.

Upon completion of his assignment in the 4th ID, LTC Green completed an Advanced Civil Schooling program at Stanford University where he earned a master's degree in Management Science & Engineering. Following graduation, LTC Green was assigned to the United States Military Academy as an instructor and then assistant professor in the Department of System Engineering.

Following his assignment at West Point, LTC Green was assigned to the 3rd Infantry Division at Fort Stewart, GA where he served as an operations officer in the division tactical operations center. He was then assigned to 2nd Brigade where he assumed the duties of operations officer of 3rd Battalion, 7th Infantry and then 3rd Battalion, 67th Armor following the brigade's conversion from an Infantry Brigade to an Armored Brigade.

LTC Green's awards and decorations include: the Bronze Star Medal, Meritorious Service Medal, the Ranger Tab, Combat Infantryman's Badge, Expert Infantryman's Badge, Senior Parachutist Badge, and the Air Assault Badge. He holds a BS in Engineering Management from the United States Military Academy and a Masters of Management Science and Engineering from Stanford University.
