MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT: Reconnaissance and Surveillance Leaders Course - Welcome Letter

- 1. Welcome to the Reconnaissance and Surveillance Leaders Course! The following information will set expectations and provide initial guidance for attending the course.
- 2. RSLC is a fast-paced course filled with physically and mentally challenging events. Over the course of 26 days, you will receive instruction on the foundations and various techniques of reconnaissance and surveillance including advanced land navigation, information collection and reporting, line-of-sight and high frequency communications, mission planning, insertion and extraction considerations, evasion and recovery, survival, and a multitude of reconnaissance and surveillance methods. Students who successfully complete this course become better Soldiers and leaders through their mastery of the fundamentals of reconnaissance and surveillance.
- 3. It is imperative that you arrive in peak physical and mental condition, ready to train. We recommend that you can score a minimum of 540 points on the ACFT and conduct a 12-mile ruck march with 35 pounds in less than 3 hours. We also recommend that you possess a basic understanding of land navigation in order to ensure a smooth transition into our advanced land navigation classes. - 4. See attached Vehicle Identification Study Guide. You must print out and study this material prior to attendance. Be sure to bring your Vehicle ID Study Guide, as it will be an inspectable item during the layout.
- 5. At 1200 hours on your report date, you will in-process under the covered training area located in front of Building 4713 at 10654 Hawkes Avenue, Fort Moore, Georgia.
