FORT BENNING, Ga. – The Maneuver Center of Excellence's Airborne and Ranger Training Brigade and the 75th Ranger Regiment will hold the 2021 Ranger Hall of Fame Induction Ceremony in Marshall Auditorium, McGinnis-Wickam Hall, July 21.
