WHAT: Maneuver Center of Excellence Infantry Week media preview, a day showcasing some of the Soldier skills that spectators may see during the upcoming competitions.

WHEN: Feb. 7, 2024, 10 a.m. – noon

WHY: Infantry Week consists of the International Sniper Competition, the Lacerda Cup All-Army Combatives Championship, the Best Mortar Competition, and the 40th annual David E. Grange Jr. Best Ranger Competition. Competitors from across the Army, Department of Defense, and international partners will compete in four major competitions during Infantry Week April 5 through 15 at Fort Moore, Ga. This Infantry Week media preview will include a combatives demonstration, a sniper stalk exercise, a 120mm mortar assembly, and the Malvesti obstacle course. The preview will also include an opportunity for media to speak with the U.S. Army Infantry School Deputy Commandant, Col. Scott P. Knight.
