# GUEST SPEAKER CSM MATTHEW D. PEELER

CSM Matthew Peeler entered service in the Oregon Army National Guard in 1998. After attending One Station Unit Training in Fort Benning, GA and being awarded MOS 11B, he completed a component transfer in 2001 where he was assigned to 1<sup>st</sup> Battalion, 5<sup>th</sup> Infantry Regiment, 1<sup>st</sup> Stryker Brigade, 25<sup>th</sup> Infantry Division, Fort Lewis Washington as an Infantry Scout. CSM Peeler deployed in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom in October 2004 as a Sniper Team Leader, where he participated in combat Operations in Fallujah, Samarra, Tikrit, Kirkuk, Mosul, Tal Afar and Sinjars Iraq.

Upon redeployment, CSM Peeler attended the US Army Recruiter School and was subsequently assigned to US Army Recruiting Station Eugene Oregon, where he served as a detailed recruiter from 2006 until 2009.

CSM Peeler was then assigned to 2<sup>nd</sup> Battalion, 23<sup>rd</sup> Infantry Regiment, 4<sup>th</sup> Stryker Brigade, 2<sup>nd</sup> Infantry Division Fort Lewis Washington where he served as a Rifle Squad Leader, Sniper Section Sergeant and Rifle Platoon Sergeant. During this assignment, CSM Peeler completed combat deployments in support of OIF in Baghdad and Taji in 2009-10, and OEF in Zabul and Kandahar provinces in 2011-12.
