SUBJECT: USE OF UNSERVICEABLE AMMUNITION FOR EMERGENCY
DESTRUCTION AND COMBAT DISPOSAL TRAINING

1. MESSAGE PROVIDES DA GUIDANCE ON THE USE OF UNSERVICEABLE AMMUNITION FOR EMERGENCY DESTRUCTION AND COMBAT DISPOSAL TRAINING. REQUEST ADDRESSEES DISTRIBUTE THIS MESSAGE TO ALL INSTALLATION TRAINING, AMMUNITION LOGISTICS, SAFETY, AND ENVIRONMENTAL PERSONNEL.
2. TO MEET MISSION REQUIREMENTS, MILITARY UNITS (E.G., EOD AND AMMUNITION UNITS) MUST MAINTAIN PROFICIENCY, KNOWLEDGE, AND SKILLS IN THE DESTRUCTION OF AMMUNITION AND EXPLOSIVES.
 - A. IN TRAINING REQUIRED TO MAINTAIN THEIR PROFICIENCY, SUCH UNITS MAY DESTROY AMMUNITION THAT HAS BEEN DETERMINED TO BE UNSERVICEABLE FOR OTHER USES. ITEMS DESIGNATED AS SUSPENDED FROM ISSUE, MOVEMENT, AND USE WILL NOT BE USED IN TRAINING WITHOUT WRITTEN AUTHORIZATION FROM JOINT MUNITIONS COMMAND (JMC)AMSJM-QAS, FOR JMC-MANAGED MUNITIONS; OR THE AVIATION AND MISSILE COMMAND (AMCOM), AFAE-MSLE-L, FOR AMCOM-MANAGED MUNITIONS.
 - B. ONLY SERVICEABLE DEMOLITION MATERIALS ARE AUTHORIZED FOR USE AS THE PRIMARY CHARGE FOR EMERGENCY DESTRUCT AND COMBAT DISPOSAL TRAINING.
 - C. UNSERVICEABLE AMMUNITION USED IN EMERGENCY DESTRUCT TRAINING:
 - (1) MUST BE DETERMINED BY THE SENIOR ASSIGNED OR SUPPORTING QASAS TO BE SAFE AND SUITABLE FOR TRANSPORT, HANDLING, AND USE FOR EMERGENCY DESTRUCT TRAINING.

(2) MUST BE SUPPORTED BY A DOCUMENTED TRAINING REQUIREMENT. (FOR EXAMPLE: AN EOD UNIT HAS A REQUIREMENT TO TRAIN THREE PERSONNEL IN PROCEDURES FOR DESTRUCTION OF HE PROJECTILES. THE ASP HAS 40 UNSERVICEABLE HE 155MM ROUNDS AND THE TRAINING PLAN CALLS FOR EACH SOLDIER TO PREPARE, PRIME, AND DETONATE 4 ROUNDS EACH. IN THIS TRAINING SCENARIO, LEGITIMATE TRAINING REQUIREMENTS EXIST FOR ONLY 12 ROUNDS, AND ONLY 12 ROUNDS ARE AUTHORIZED FOR ISSUE.)

(3) MUST BE REQUESTED, ISSUED, AND DOCUMENTED PER STANDARD AMMUNITION REQUEST, ISSUE, AND RECEIPT PROCEDURES.

D. INSTALLATIONS WILL SUBMIT AN AMMUNITION CONDITION REPORT (ACR) FOR DISPOSITION OF ANY REMAINING UNSERVICEABLE ROUNDS. ACRS MUST BE SUBMITTED TO THE APPROPRIATE JMC OR AMCOM ITEM MANAGER. (NOTE: JMC LOCATIONS ARE NOT REQUIRED TO SUBMIT ACRS FOR DISPOSITION OF UNSERVICEABLE MUNITIONS.)

3. THE USE AND DESTRUCTION OF UNSERVICEABLE AMMUNITION AS PART OF A LEGITIMATE TRAINING SCENARIO DOES NOT VIOLATE EPA'S MILITARY MUNITIONS RULE. ALL SUCH TRAINING MUST BE PREPLANNED. THE APPROPRIATE DEMOLITION MATERIALS NEEDED FOR TRAINING MUST BE FORECASTED. ALL TRAINING REQUIREMENTS AND EXERCISES WILL BE DOCUMENTED, WITH THE RECORDS RETAINED, BY THE TRAINING UNIT, FOR 3 YEARS.

4. TRAINING PLANS WILL NOT BE "TAILORED" TO DISPOSE OF UNSERVICEABLE AMMUNITION, AS THIS COULD BE CONSIDERED "SHAM" TRAINING AND SUBJECT TO ACTION UNDER EPA'S MILITARY MUNITIONS RULE. ONLY THE TYPES AND AMOUNTS OF AMMUNITION NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH DOCUMENTED TRAINING OBJECTIVES ARE AUTHORIZED FOR ISSUE.
