

MEMORANDUM FOR TRAINERS

SUBJECT: Range Bulletin: 03-16 for Period 17 MAR – 13 APR 16

1. **Range Operations:**a. **Weekly firing schedule/hours of support currently in-place.**

- In the future we will be going to 24-7 hours training support window for the Radio Room Operations. This means Units will be able to train “HOT” or “COLD” any time of the day with exceptions identified below. However, range support with limited manpower will still require advanced notification and possible overtime (OT) if beyond the norm of M-F, 0600-2400 hours training. Remember, just because OT funding is available, does not mean manpower is as well so plan well in advance. **This rule does not apply to contractor run ranges as they have set schedules and limited support. Anything beyond normal support hours requires contract modifications, which must be identified a minimum of 6-weeks in advance.**

- **Weekend maintenance** support is no longer available on the Installation due to manpower constraints and reductions in LWS personnel. Current maintenance support is until 1400 hours, M-F with nothing after that. Units wishing to execute training after this time frame and on weekends will get what they get when they turn the power on. If systems/targets fail, no troubleshooting or tech support will be available until the next scheduled work day, with no support at all on the weekends. Also with no manning in Operations scheduling section on the weekends, Units will not have the option of moving to another range if they encounter issues with their scheduled facility.

- **Federal Holidays** IAW Chief, Range Division the fire desk is open 24/7/364 and are we are only projecting to close down for the Christmas Day Holiday each year. “Live Firing and Cold Training” is not authorized on this day, however exceptions may be considered. Exceptions to this policy will require DPTMS approval and OT funding costs will be paid by requesting Unit for any/all support purposes during Federal Holiday.

b. **Hospital Closure Extension:** The old Martin Army demolition has been extended and training has now been extended to September 2016. Same SOP and rules are still in place.

c. **McKenna Mount and McKenna Strip:** All training requests for McKenna MOUT and/or McKenna and Strip must go to Mr. Bruce Henry, bruce.m.henry.ctr@mail.mil and Mr. Gentry Sprout, Gentry gentry.j.sprout.ctr@mail.mil for coordination and approval.

d. **Hand Grenade/Britten Range Training Requests:** All Hand Grenade/Britten Range RFMSS requests need to be accompanied with a 316 CAV Unit Training Coordination Sheet before they will be process. These coordination sheets can be sent to us via email so we can attach to the RFMSS request for processing. Now this does NOT apply to OSUT (198th) or BCT (194th) Units as they are all covered under the Hand Grenade Committee for this range.

h. **WCLS Funding Cuts:** Effective 1 May 16 the Army is again cutting funding to the Warfighter Focus Contract that may again impact the DMPRC, CACTF facilities and Malone 2 as far as on-site support goes. This will reduce the manning levels on the DMPRC from 28 down to 20 personnel from what we are being told. We are now researching what these personnel reductions may do as far as functions which may no longer be provided to Units. We will let all know as soon as we get to the ground truth on this.

j. **Instrumented Shoot Houses:** Pyrotechnics, grenade simulators, flash bangs, etc, of any kind are not allowed in the Buchanan instrumented shoot house as they will damage the equipment. On the other shoot houses that do not have this technology (Brann, Booker, Farnsworth), it is permissible to use these type training enablers as long as it is approved in the training packet and it is requested on your RFMSS request in advance of your training dates.

k. **Operations De-Confliction Meeting Schedule:** Conduct of the Range Operations De-Confliction meeting will now be executed one time per month. See the schedule below for projected meeting dates.

o. **Range Division Supply:** Will be closed every Monday. Units that have a Range scheduled on Monday need to sign out a MA-CON Radio on Thursday or Friday. If there are any emergency situations, the POC is Vivian Parnell or Bruce Johnson at (706) 545-2497/3132.

p. **Zero Target POCs:** Units needing zero targets will need to contact Mr. Ronnie Williams, 545-5677 for Alpha Area and Malone Ranges and **SFC Ferari, 544-0467** for the Oscar Area Ranges. Ensure this is done in advance (usually the day before) of actual training event(s) as same day requests may not be able to be supported along with normal mission requirements.

q. **Big Gun/Kilo Area Range Scheduling/Coordination Requirements:** All units wanting to occupy & train on Brooks, Cactus, Carmouche, DMPRC, Ruth, Hastings, Terry Demo, K-36 Ranger Objective and Ware ranges, all indirect firing points or any Air Missions into the K-15 impact area will have to follow the procedures outlined below. Units will not be able to occupy any of these ranges prior to 0530 on the day of training, unless coordination is made well in advance for personnel support. Make sure when you request these type facilities that you have a day at the end of your firing exercise set aside for range clearance, which must be done in the day light hours.

- Ensure event and facility needed is locked on the Range Operations Big Gun Calendar
- Submit RFMSS request for date & times needed with a day-by-day detailed gun line.
- Conduct face-to-face final coordination with Mr. Hattaway, 545-3010 for all ranges except the DMPRC and Terry Demo, Mr. Cribb, 626-2678 is the POC for the DMPRC, and Mr. Williams (706) 545-5677 is the POC for Terry demo. Coordination is required NLT 7-days in advance from event start time (NLT 6-weeks out if overtime is needed). Due to range division manpower shortages you may run into any/all of the following, so ensure you plan ahead for any training/certification needs your Unit may require to ensure mission success in these dire times.

Tower Operators will have to ensure towers are powered down daily when mission is complete and Units are self-running a range.

- Request/change is asked for too late as work schedule are already published, however OT may be able to be applied if manpower if available. The DMPC even though contractor supported cannot have any changes under the two week time frame that may affect work schedules. We are required by contract to contractor a minimum of 2-weeks' notice to work schedule adjustments and OT cannot be applied here. No available tower operators. No range personnel to prep ranges, day or night. No range personnel to repair malfunctions or troubleshoot, day or night. No moving targets will be available when Range Division support is not in place.

Recommend all keep an eye on these schedules/routes and inform all Units operating in and around them to be aware of these convoys, as these are large vehicles carrying oversized loads to and from training facilities/ranges on the installation and we need to keep all safe. All HETS movements along the northern installation boundary hardball road that goes from Ruth to Hastings needs to be coordinated in advance. Remember, the Unit is responsible for scheduling HETS delivery/pickup and de-conflicting routes/timelines with other Units and Safety patrol if gate access is needed. xi. **E-8 Fencing Project:** The E-8 impact area will now be fenced in completely and have signage posted around this off-limits area. This will bring us into compliance with DA PAM 385-63 directives that require us to have positive controls for access into permanent/dedicated impact areas. Project is funded waiting approval of 144-R with an estimated completion date TBD as [deferred funding](#).

xii. **Fowler Range:** In an attempt to meet all Units requirements for LOMAH training we are now enforcing the rule that only allows Units only use this range when they have LOMAH requirements, all other BRM training will need to move to other facilities to better utilize our assets. This will free time up for our LWS repair folks to conduct normal required maintenance to keep these facilities up and running, especially with Malone 2 down for revamp until at least **Apr 16. Currently this range is down indefinitely for connectivity and water issues within the power/fiber boxes, more to follow as we identify repairs and path forward for fixes.**

xiii. **Garnsey Range:** Work is now under by DPW at this time to fill in fiber holes. Permanently closing down Objectives D-E on this facility at this time. They are also attempting to find out why we do not have connectivity between the tower and the targets, seems like more fiber issues. **Until further notice this range is closed for all lie fire events.**

xiv. **Good Hope Maneuver Training Area (GHMTA):** The Good Hope Maneuver area is opened up for mounted and dismounted training for all Installation Units as well as for 19K OSUT drivers training requirements. All requests for the GHMTA will now be routed through and approved by 2-16 CAV for CO-USE concurrence before we can process any requests for this area. Commander's must ensure Units follow the standard rules for the GHMTA which will prevent possible EMD fines and area closure due to environmental violations which must include a maneuver damage control cell plan IAW embedded .pdf below which must also be spelled out in the 144R or they won't approve it. **All Units will be required to submit and get 144R approval for each training event/iteration.** with the exception of 2-16 BOLC whose 144R is valid for a 1-year period. Also all need to be aware that we still have contractors working within the boundaries of the GHMTA, so keep this in mind

During ABOLC training in the GHMTA, all designated Heavy Maneuver areas will be utilized. Units wishing co-use, which include any portion of the Heavy Maneuver areas, must coordinate and present a CONOP for de-confliction and approval to D Troop, 2-16 CAV (Tactics Troop). Once complete, the unit RFMSS request will be approved by the Squadron S3 office.


