Processing takes four days, however due to your arrival date, cycle scheduling, expect to be assigned to the 30th AG BN (REC) anywhere from 5-7 days; potentially longer if issues arise regarding your physical, mental or morale health.

A safe and secure environment as you prepare for Basic Combat Training or One Station Unit Training.

To receive 7 hours of sleep each night.

To be held to a daily increasing standard of personal military conduct as we teach you basic Soldier skills.

To be held accountable for your commitment to excellence. Our job is to help you overcome fear and hardship, not avoid it.

The opportunity to contact your family the evening of day 1 to inform them of your safe arrival at Fort Benning.

The opportunity to contact your family the night before or morning of your ship to training.

There are no pay phones located in the battalion.

The opportunity to purchase lost or forgotten necessities at the 30th AG PX.
