MEMORANDUM FOR Tenants of the Villages of Benning

SUBJECT: Order to Report COVID-19 Self Quarantine in the Villages of Benning

1. As the Garrison Commander for Fort Benning, I maintain legal authority over the security of this installation, including the health, welfare, safety and security of any persons working on or living within its boundaries. This includes the homes and all residents of the Villages of Benning, as well as first responders and maintenance personnel. Therefore, I hereby order any and all residents of the Villages of Benning to report cases of self-quarantine for COVID-19.
2. This information will strictly be used to ensure our first responders and maintenance personnel entering residences occupied by self-quarantined individuals take the appropriate precautions.
3. For the duration of this order, I suspend routine and preventative maintenance work orders, which require maintenance personnel to enter a home. Response personnel will prioritize emergency, life/health/safety-related, and urgent work orders.
4. This order is effective immediately and will remain in effect until 11 May 20, or until I rescind the order in writing. This order includes self-quarantines currently in place and those already completed. Compliance is required upon the notification from a medical professional, or other means directing self-quarantine, e.g. chain of command. This notification is required to mitigate the risk or concern of being infected with COVID-19 virus.
5. To report self-quarantines contact the Garrison Housing Chief, Mr. Keith R. Lovejoy at keith.r.lovejoy.civ@mail.mil. The e-mail report will include: (i) name, (ii) address, (iii) telephone number, and (iv) projected end date of self-quarantine. This reporting is in addition to service members informing their chain of command.
6. This order is punitive in nature for all assigned military personnel. Additionally, failure to follow this order could result in a barment notice from Fort Benning for ANY resident who does not comply.
