Frequently Asked Questions

1. Q. Does the Exchange accept on line coupons?

A. The Exchange now accepts online-printed internet coupons in addition to traditional paper coupons.

2. Q. Why do some Exchange Concessions charge customers sales tax?

A. The majority of our vendors and concessions are private business owners who have to pay state and local taxes and must, by law, charge the customer the same tax.

3. Q. How can I find out about local events at the Exchange?

A. Customers can voluntarily sign up for the local Buddy emails sent out weekly advertising local sales promotions. Customers simply provide their personal email address to the local PX. Email addresses are kept confidential and are not shared with anyone.

4. Q. If I happen to find something sold for less outside the installation, will the Exchange match the price?

A. Yes, the Exchange will match the price on identical regularly stocked items sold for less elsewhere. Simply notify the cashier for anything less than \$10 difference. Anything more than \$10 will be verified with the retailer.

5. Q. How does the Exchange decide their clothing assortments?

A. The Exchange has centralized buyers who buy fashion and basic clothing goods for all of AAFES. The local stores tailor their quantities for each category and ensure the categories line up with local demographics and prior season sales history. Fashion goods are procured six months in advance. Size runs for each fashion grouping are based on industry standards.
