- Constantly water live trees to prevent house fires.
- When setting up a Christmas tree or other display, make sure doors and passageways are clear inside your home.

The application period for the **2025-2026** academic year will open on *December 11, 2024* and close on *February 12, 2025*.

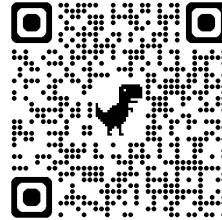
