Holiday Safety Tips

- Request MP conduct quarters checks when departing the area.
- Do not leave packages or valuables on the seat of your car.
- Be extra cautious about locking doors and windows when you leave the house, even for a few minutes.
- Have a neighbor or family member watch your house and pick up your newspapers and mail.
- Indoor and outdoor lights should be on an automatic timer.
- **Large displays of holiday gifts should not be visible through the windows and doors of your home.**
- **Do not place high value refuse curbside to tell everyone what was purchased.** Break up boxes and bag them. Bring them to the recycling points.
- Constantly water live trees to prevent house fires.
- When setting up a Christmas tree or other display, make sure doors and passageways are clear inside your home.

Weapons Registration

MANDATORY:

On Post Resident: **24-hour registration requirement** from the time you bring the firearm on post.

Off Post Resident: hunting or use of installation ranges (MWR).

AAFES Purchases: 3-day wait period




Registration:

1. Complete FM (DES) Form 190-11-R. (Firearms Registration Form)
2. Requires your Commander's approval and signature, email or drop off to DES.

***Firearms must be transported in a gun case, unloaded, and not in plain view from outside the vehicle. If the vehicle has a trunk the firearm must be transported in the trunk. Ammunition must be separated from the firearm.**







Let Faucets Drip



Turn Heat On
Auto

- Drip all outdoor faucets (just a slow, steady drip) — this keeps water moving and helps prevent freezing.
- Drip indoor faucets located on outside walls, especially in kitchens, bathrooms, and laundry rooms.
- Turn your heat on "AUTO" and set the thermostat to at least 65°F — even if you'll be away.
- Open cabinet doors under sinks to allow warm air to circulate around pipes.
- Disconnect garden hoses from outdoor spigots.
- Close garage doors to keep warmer air inside and protect water heaters or utility areas.
- Cover outdoor faucets with foam covers, towels, or even a small bucket for extra protection.
- Keep interior doors open to promote even heating throughout your home.
- If you're traveling, ask a neighbor to check your home or leave your heat running at 65°F or higher.

Pet Safety Reminders

- Bring pets indoors during freezing temperatures — if it's too cold for you, it's too cold for them.
- If pets must be outside briefly, provide shelter, dry bedding, and access to unfrozen water.
- Keep an eye out for neighborhood pets who may need a little extra help staying warm.

The application period for the 2026-2027 academic year will open on December 10, 2025 and close on February 11, 2026. Recipients will be notified of their status by mail on or about May 15, 2026. Due to the volume of applications, non-recipients are not notified.

The **Scholarships for Military Children Program** is designed to award scholarships annually at each commissary operated by the Defense Commissary Agency worldwide, with funding provided through generous contributions.

For the 2026-2027 academic year, **500 scholarships valued at \$2,000 each** will be awarded. At least one recipient will be selected at every commissary location where qualified applications are received. Additional awards are allocated on a prorated basis, meaning commissaries with larger applicant pools may have more than one recipient.






