Arrest Scams and Reporting

Arrest scams involve fraudsters **impersonating law enforcement, federal agents, or court officials** to intimidate victims into **paying fake fines via gift cards, cryptocurrency, or wire transfers** to avoid immediate, bogus arrest warrants. They often use **spoofed caller IDs**, fake documents, and high-pressure tactics, **commonly claiming missed jury duty or warrants**.

Key Indicators and Tactics:

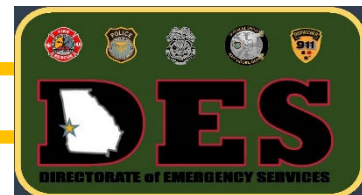
- **Impersonation:** Scammers pose as U.S. Marshals, sheriff deputies, or IRS agents.
- **Urgency & Threats:** Intimidation via phone or video calls, threatening immediate arrest or "digital arrest".
- **Payment Demands:** Requesting payment via Bitcoin ATMs, prepaid debit cards (e.g., Green Dot), or wire transfers.
- **Spoofed Information:** Caller ID may appear to be from a legitimate courthouse or law enforcement agency.
- **Fake Documentation:** Sending forged arrest warrants or documents via email or text.

How to Protect Yourself:

- **Hang Up:** Immediately hang up if a caller demands money to avoid arrest.
- **Verify Independently:** Do not trust the caller. Look up the official number for the agency and call them directly.
- **Never Pay with Gift Cards:** Law enforcement will never demand payment in gift cards, cryptocurrency, or wire transfers.
- **Ignore Threats:** Legitimate law enforcement will not call you to warn of an arrest warrant.

Weapons Registration

MANDATORY:

On Post Resident: **24-hour registration requirement** from the time you bring the firearm on post.

Off Post Resident: hunting or use of installation ranges (MWR).

AAFES Purchases: 3-day wait period



Registration:

1. Complete FB FM (DES) Form 190-11-R. (Firearms Registration Form)
2. Requires your Commander's approval and signature, email or drop off to DES.

***Firearms must be transported in a gun case, unloaded, and not in plain view from outside the vehicle. If the vehicle has a trunk the firearm must be transported in the trunk. Ammunition must be separated from the firearm.**

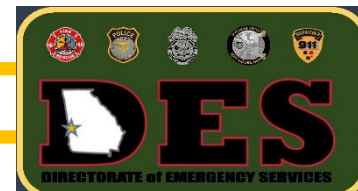

TRICARE For Life (TFL)

- I will be 65 soon and will become entitled to Medicare. How does that affect my TRICARE benefit?
 - If you are entitled to premium-free Medicare Part A, you must also have Medicare Part B to remain TRICARE-eligible.
- I was enrolled in TRICARE Prime at a military hospital. I received a letter from the military hospital telling me I am no longer eligible for enrollment in TRICARE Prime. What does that mean?
 - Once you become entitled to premium-free Medicare Part A because you are age 65, you are eligible for TFL when you also have Medicare Part B. You are no longer eligible for enrollment in TRICARE Prime, unless you have an active-duty sponsor.



TRICARE For Life (TFL)

- Does TFL pay for the Medicare Part B premium and deductible?
 - The Medicare Part B monthly premium is your responsibility
 - In most cases, your provider files your claims with Medicare.
 - Medicare pays its portion first and sends the claim to the TFL claims processor.
 - TRICARE then pays the provider directly for TRICARE-covered services.
 - Generally, you'll have no out-of-pocket costs for services that both Medicare and TRICARE cover.
 - You will have out-of-pocket costs for care that is not covered by Medicare, TRICARE, or both.

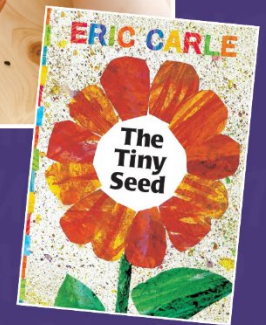

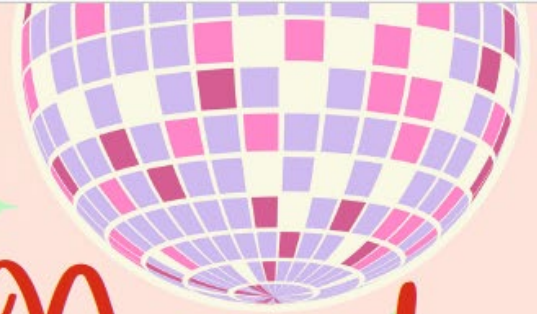

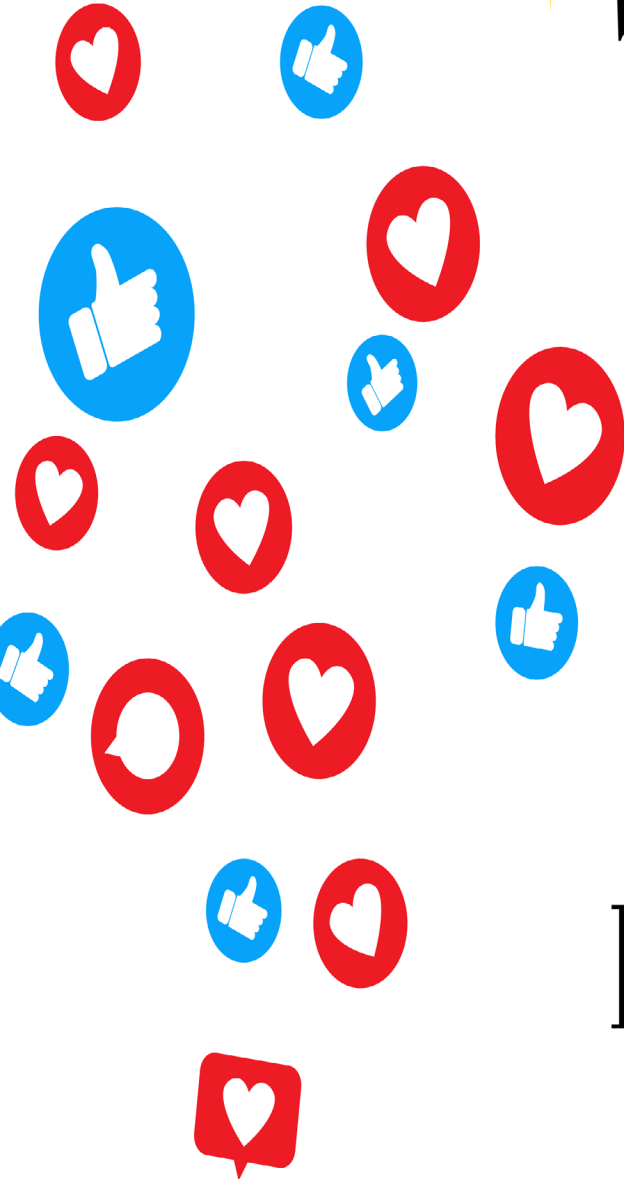

The application period for the 2026-2027 academic year will open on December 10, 2025 and close on February 11, 2026. Recipients will be notified of their status by mail on or about May 15, 2026. Due to the volume of applications, non-recipients are not notified.

The **Scholarships for Military Children Program** is designed to award scholarships annually at each commissary operated by the Defense Commissary Agency worldwide, with funding provided through generous contributions.

For the 2026–2027 academic year, **500 scholarships valued at \$2,000 each** will be awarded. At least one recipient will be selected at every commissary location where qualified applications are received. Additional awards are allocated on a prorated basis, meaning commissaries with larger applicant pools may have more than one recipient.

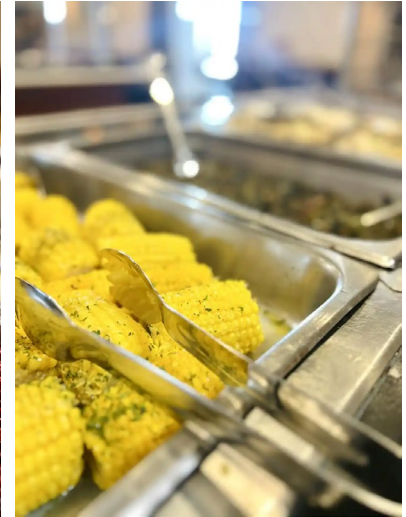

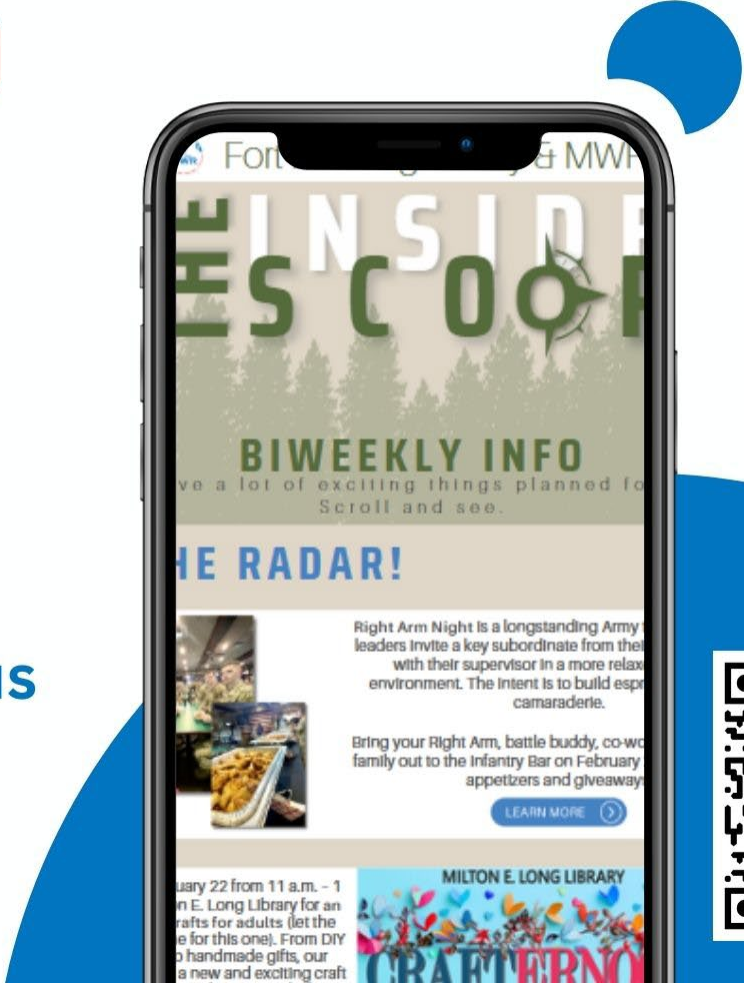
